

## **GET HELP IN YOUR LANGUAGE**

Upon request, parents have the right to interpretation at special education meetings, and translation of IEPs, assessments and notices. You can request language access services by speaking with a member of your child's IEP team. You can also request a translation of your child's IEP by visiting schools.nyc.gov/IEPHello or by calling 718-935-2013. If you have concerns regarding language access services, please follow the escalation process described on the DOE's website (at <u>schools.nyc.gov/connect-with-us</u>). If your concern is not resolved at the school or district level, you may file a complaint. Details on how to file a complaint are explained on the DOE's website (at <u>https://www.schools.nyc.gov/school-life/school-environment/get-help/parent-complaints-and-appeals</u>).
