



WELCOME

TO KINDERGARTEN and GIFTED & TALENTED ADMISSIONS

Applying to kindergarten is an exciting first step in your child's elementary school journey. New York City students apply to kindergarten in the year they turn five. Between late November 2018 and January 14, 2019, apply to kindergarten by submitting a kindergarten application. You can apply to up to 12 kindergarten programs.

You can also schedule your child to take the Gifted & Talented (G&T) test. Students who get a high enough score can then apply to kindergarten G&T programs.

Use this admissions guide to learn about how to apply to kindergarten, how to study for the G&T test and participate in G&T admissions, and how students get kindergarten and G&T offers. Find schools near you on our district maps. Then visit  [MySchools.nyc](https://www.myschools.nyc.gov) to learn more about them and apply.

No school may deny admission, registration, or enrollment to a student based on the student's proficiency or perceived proficiency in English. The NYC Department of Education provides a range of supports and services for English Language Learner (ELL) students to develop their English language skills and prepare them for success in school and beyond.

- You can apply directly to kindergarten DL programs by adding those programs to your child's application. Learn more in **Section 3.4**.

Every elementary school participating in kindergarten and Gifted & Talented admissions is expected to welcome and serve students with disabilities in accordance with their Individualized Education Programs (IEPs). To participate in kindergarten admissions, students with disabilities follow the same steps outlined in this guide as their general education peers.

Accessibility | schools.nyc.gov/BuildingAccessibility

The NYC Department of Education is committed to providing students with accessibility needs with a kindergarten placement that allows the student to access all relevant programs and services. Accessible schools or programs are located in a fully accessible building or a partially accessible building where an individual with limited mobility may enter and access all relevant programs and services, including the science laboratory, library, cafeteria, and gymnasium, and at least one restroom is accessible. All schools that are considered accessible are labeled as fully accessible or partially accessible in the School Information and Maps pages of this admissions guide.

For the most up-to-date information on school building accessibility, contact schools directly or visit them in person.

Students in Temporary Housing | schools.nyc.gov/STH

Families with students in temporary housing should apply to kindergarten and Gifted & Talented programs even if their housing situation is uncertain.

- Students in temporary housing, as defined by The McKinney-Vento Homeless Assistance Act, are not required to submit documentation (including address, proof of date of birth, and immunization) in order to participate in an admissions process or enroll in school.
- Some students in temporary housing or with families facing extreme hardship may have needs that require special consideration in order to take the G&T test, such as changing a testing date. Learn more in **Section 7.3**.

KINDERGARTEN and GIFTED & TALENTED ACTION CHECKLIST

OCTOBER

- Use this admissions guide to learn about kindergarten and Gifted & Talented (G&T) admissions.
- Find your zoned school at schools.nyc.gov/Find-a-School or by calling **311**. Most NYC students attend kindergarten at their zoned school.
- G&T** | Use MySchools (MySchools.nyc) to schedule your child's G&T test by **November 9, 2018**. To apply for G&T programs in the spring, your child must get a qualifying score on this test.
 - Confirm your child's G&T test date and location.
 - Prepare for the G&T test with your child by reviewing the practice test in this guide.
- Learn about admissions events and open houses at schools.nyc.gov/Kindergarten.
 - Attend an elementary admissions event near you.
 - Visit schools. For the most up-to-date open house information, contact schools directly.

NOVEMBER–DECEMBER

- November:** Kindergarten application period opens! Use MySchools (MySchools.nyc) to explore NYC public schools and programs, find choices for your application, and apply—all in one place. Applying online is easy and fast.
 - Explore your kindergarten options and find schools that meet your family's needs.
 - Choose up to 12 kindergarten programs and add them to your child's application.
 - Submit your application.

More Ways to Apply

JANUARY

- Kindergarten application period closes! Apply to kindergarten by **January 14, 2019**. Even after submitting your application, you can make changes to it in MySchools (MySchools.nyc) until the January 14 deadline.
- G&T** | Students born in 2014 who are scheduled to take the G&T test will do so on a weekend day at a designated testing site.

MARCH–APRIL

- Get your child's kindergarten offer.
- Pre-register in person at the school to accept your child's kindergarten offer; bring your child and all required documents. Even if you hope to get an offer to a G&T program later, accept this offer now. G&T programs are in very high demand, so placement is not guaranteed regardless of a child's overall G&T score.
- G&T** | Get your child's G&T score report. If your child gets an eligible score, you will also get a G&T application.
 - G&T** | Attend school tours for G&T programs.
 - G&T** | Submit your G&T application.


JUNE

- G&T** | If you applied to G&T programs, get your G&T results.
- G&T** | Accept or decline your child's G&T offer. Pre-register at the school in person; bring your child and all required documents.

1.0 Know the Paths to Elementary School

All New York City children born in 2014 will begin kindergarten in September 2019 and are guaranteed a kindergarten seat at a public school. Once your child starts kindergarten, they can remain at the same school until its final elementary grade.

There are two paths to elementary admissions:



All families are encouraged to participate in both kindergarten and G&T admissions.

1.1 Applying to Kindergarten

Submit your child’s kindergarten application online, by phone, or in person at a Family Welcome Center between late **November 2018** and **January 14, 2019**—learn more in **Section 2.0**. You can apply to up to 12 schools. In March, you’ll get one kindergarten offer. Pre-register in person at the school to accept this offer even if you are hoping for a G&T or waitlist offer.

1.2 Testing for Gifted & Talented Programs

G&T programs are one way that New York City meets the needs of exceptional students. If you would like to have your child tested, schedule a date for their G&T test online or in person at a Family Welcome Center or, if applicable, through your child’s current DOE public school. The deadline for scheduling the test is **November 9, 2018**. Students who are scheduled will take the test in **January 2019**. In April, you will get your child’s score report. If their score is high enough, you will also get a G&T application and can apply to G&T programs. In June, you will get your child’s G&T results. If these results include an offer, accept or decline that offer by pre-registering in June.

1.3 Who Can Participate?

To apply for kindergarten or schedule the G&T test, your child must be a current New York City resident who was born in 2014. Kindergarten and G&T admissions are open to all students of this age, including current pre-K students at DOE public schools, pre-K centers, NYC Early Education Centers (NYCEECs), charter schools, and private and parochial schools; students with disabilities; students learning English; students with accessibility needs; and students in temporary housing. Students currently attending pre-K at a public elementary school still need to apply to kindergarten.

If you move to New York City during the school year and need to find an elementary school now, visit schools.nyc.gov/NewStudents to learn how to enroll.

Tip: Charter schools are free public schools that operate independently from the Department of Education (DOE). Charter schools have a separate kindergarten application process, but any student eligible for admission to a DOE public school is eligible for admission to a charter school. If you would like to apply to a charter school, please contact that school directly to learn how to apply. You can find charter elementary schools near you in the maps of this admissions guide—for more information, visit schools.nyc.gov/Charters or call **212-374-5419**.

KINDERGARTEN ADMISSIONS

2.0 Apply to Kindergarten

Apply to kindergarten between **late November 2018** and **January 14, 2019**.

2.1 How to Apply

You can apply one of three ways.

Recommended!

Online at MySchools.nyc

MySchools is both an online directory of NYC public schools and a personalized application for your child.

- Explore DOE public elementary schools, find choices for your child's application, and apply—all in one place.
- Apply in English, Spanish, Chinese, Bengali, Russian, Arabic, Urdu, Haitian Creole, Korean, or French.
- Apply anytime—this option is available 24 hours a day.
- Apply by **Monday, January 14, 2019** at 11:59pm—make changes to your application anytime before this deadline.

By phone at 718-935-2009

- Call us Monday through Friday from 8am to 6pm
- Apply by phone in over 200 languages. If you speak a language other than English, ask for an interpreter.
- Apply by **Monday, January 14, 2019** at 6pm.

In person at a Family Welcome Center

- Visit us Monday through Thursday from 8am to 5pm and Friday from 8am to 3pm—see the inside back cover of this directory for locations and hours.
- Apply in person in over 200 languages. If you speak a language other than English, ask for an interpreter.
- Apply by **Monday, January 14, 2019** at 3pm.

Kindergarten admissions is not first come, first served. All applications submitted by the **January 14** deadline are treated the same based on admissions priorities (see **Sections 4.3-4.7**).

Only a child's primary custodial parent or guardian can submit their kindergarten application.



Tip:

G&T programs have a separate admissions process and you cannot add them to your kindergarten application. To participate in G&T admissions, schedule an appointment for your child to take the G&T test by **November 9, 2018**.

2.2 Families with Multiple Children Applying to Kindergarten

If you have more than one child applying to kindergarten and want your children to attend the same school, you will have the option to apply for both or all children at the same time.

3.0 Learn About Schools and Programs

When you apply to kindergarten, you are not just applying to schools—you are applying to programs. Think of a program as a “doorway” to get into the school. Many elementary schools have only one program, but some have two or more, such as a general education program and a Dual Language program. In your kindergarten application, you will be able to see both the school and program name for each of your kindergarten choices.

Use the district maps in this guide and MySchools ( [MySchools.nyc](https://www.myschools.nyc.gov)) to research your child's kindergarten options.

Maps

The maps in this book are organized by district and show the location of all DOE public elementary schools and charter elementary schools in each district. The map spreads also offer the following information:

- Grades served at the school
- Dual Language programs offered
- Kindergarten G&T programs offered
- If the program admitted non-zoned students in 2018
- The school's degree of accessibility. Accessible schools or programs are located in one of the following types of buildings:
 -  A fully accessible building is a building that is constructed post-1992, complies with all of the ADA's design requirements, and has no barriers to access for persons with mobility impairments.
 -  In contrast, a partially accessible building allows persons with mobility impairments to enter and exit the building, access all relevant programs and services, including the science laboratory, library, cafeteria, and gymnasium, and have use of at least one restroom, but the entire building may not be accessible. In some cases, school programs may need to be relocated to accommodate access.

School Quality Reports

You can learn about a school's performance in terms of academics and safety by reading its School Quality Reports; search for any school at schools.nyc.gov/Find-a-School and select the Data and Reports tab.



Tip:

There are 32 school districts in NYC. Your child has a higher chance of getting into a school in your district than outside of your district. Find your school district by calling **311**, visiting schools.nyc.gov/Find-a-School, or using MySchools (MySchools.nyc).

3.1 School Types

There are two types of schools that you can add to your child's kindergarten application.

- **Zoned Schools:** Most NYC families have a zoned school, which means they live in an area zoned for a specific school and their children have priority to attend it. Your zoned school, if you have one, is the school where your child is most likely to go to kindergarten. Most zoned schools make kindergarten offers to all students living in the zone. Some zoned schools have room to make offers to children living outside of their zone.
- **Non-Zoned Schools:** These schools do not have a zone. Families throughout the district or borough can attend them. Most non-zoned schools give priority to students who have older siblings attending, who are current pre-K students, or who live in the district.

There are three districts in NYC where all the schools are non-zoned, and students living in these districts have priority to attend all schools in the district. These districts are:

- District 1: Lower East Side Manhattan
- District 7: South Bronx
- District 23: Brownsville Brooklyn



Tip:

Learn if you have a zoned school by calling **311** or using MySchools (MySchools.nyc).

3.2 Magnet Schools

Magnet schools are public schools that provide a school-wide curriculum designed around a specific theme. They are intended to attract a diverse pool of applicants and historically have accommodated students from outside their zone or district. While some schools may have the word “magnet” in their school's name, only a school that currently gets Magnet Schools Assistance Program (M.S.A.P) funding will be labeled as a “magnet school” in MySchools (MySchools.nyc).

3.3 Special Music School

There is one elementary school that requires an audition as part of its admissions process. If you add Special Music School to your child's application, be sure to also schedule your child's audition—to do so, contact the school directly one of the following ways:


3.4 Dual Language Programs

In Dual Language (DL) programs, students are taught in two languages: English and their home language, such as Spanish, Chinese, or French, among others. The goal of this program is for students to be able to read, write, and speak in both English and their home language. DL programs aim for a balanced number of English Language Learners (ELLs) and English-speaking students, so some seats may be reserved for ELLs. In order to determine who might be an ELL, schools may conduct an assessment and an interview with the child to determine home language and English proficiency. However, this cannot be used to override a DOE offer. If you are interested in a DL program, be sure to apply to that program—not the school’s general education program—on your kindergarten application.

4.0 Know Your Chances

All NYC children born in 2014 are guaranteed a kindergarten seat in a public school.

How can you know your child’s chances of getting an offer from one of your favorite schools? A number of factors play a role in how students get offers.



4.1 Your Application Choices

The schools that you add to your child’s application and the order in which you place them help determine where your child goes to kindergarten.

1. Choose up to 12 schools that you’d like your child to attend.
2. Add these programs to their kindergarten application
3. Order these school choices in the application from favorite to least favorite, with your favorite school at the top in the #1 spot.

Your child will get an offer to your highest possible choice considering seat availability and admissions priorities.

Tip: Some schools offer more than one program, so be sure to add the correct program—such as a Dual Language program—to your application. If you would like your child to attend your zoned school, add it to your application. However, you do not have to place it as your first choice.

4.2 Seat Availability

Schools vary in size and demand. When a school has more applicants than seats, it can't make offers to everyone who wants to attend it—in this case, offers are made first to the students who have the highest admissions priority to attend the school.

4.3 Types of Admissions Priorities

Your child has a better chance of getting an offer from some schools than others. A school's admissions priorities determine the order in which groups of applicants are considered for offers.

- Students are considered in groups, and all students in the first priority group will be considered first.
- If seats are available, students in the second priority group will be considered next, and so on.



Tip:

Use MySchools ([MySchools.nyc](https://www.myschools.nyc.gov)) to learn about a school's admissions priorities and who got offers in 2018. This information will help you know your child's chances of getting an offer to a particular school.

- The higher priority your child has to attend a school, the higher the chance that your child will get an offer to that school.
 - If a school made offers to a specific group of students in 2018, they may be able to make offers to this group again. For example, if a school was able to make offers to children living outside of their zone who had an older sibling in the school, they may be able to make offers to siblings living outside of the zone again.
-

Sibling Priority

Elementary schools offer an admissions priority to applicants whose siblings attend the same school. If your child has an older sibling at a school that you've added to their application, your child may have a higher chance of getting an offer from that school than an applicant without an enrolled sibling. To make sure your child gets sibling priority, be sure to provide or confirm sibling information when you apply.

A sibling is defined as an applicant's brother or sister, including half-brothers, half-sisters, stepbrothers, stepsisters, foster brothers, and foster sisters who live in the same household and are currently pre-registered or enrolled at that school in any grade level between kindergarten and grade 12, and who will be enrolled at that school in any grade level between kindergarten and grade 12 in September 2019. This includes students enrolled in District 75 programs in the same school building.

Pre-K Priority

If your child is currently enrolled in pre-K at a DOE public elementary school, they will have an admissions priority to attend kindergarten at that school. Not all elementary schools have pre-K. Students currently attending pre-K at a public elementary school still need to apply to kindergarten.

District Priority

Most schools give an admissions priority to students in their own district over students who live in other districts.

4.4 Admissions Priorities for Zoned Schools

All zoned schools make offers to students in the following order:

1. Students who live in the zone and have a sibling at the school
2. Other students who live in the zone

If space allows, students living outside the zone may also be admitted, in the following order:

3. Students with a sibling at the school who live in the district
4. Students with a sibling at the school who live outside the district
5. Students who live in the district and are currently enrolled at the school for pre-K
6. Students who live outside the district and are currently enrolled at the school for pre-K
7. Other students who live in the district
8. Other students who live outside the district



Tip:

Use the **School Information and Map pages** in this guide to see which zoned schools admitted non-zoned students last year.

4.5 Admissions Priorities for Non-Zoned Schools

Different non-zoned schools have different admissions priorities, but most non-zoned schools give students who live in the same district an admissions priority. You can look up any school's admissions priorities in MySchools ([↗ MySchools.nyc](https://www.myschools.nyc.gov)) and find out which priority group your child is in.

4.6 District-Specific Admissions Priorities

Some districts—such as Districts 1, 7, and 23 have district-specific admissions priorities. Learn more about your district's schools in the **School Information and Maps pages** of this guide.

4.7 Diversity in Admissions

Elementary schools across the city are participating in an effort to increase diversity in their programs by giving admissions priorities to students who qualify for free and reduced lunch (FRL), students in temporary housing, English Language Learners, and other groups. The current list of schools participating in diversity pilots is available on our website—learn more at schools.nyc.gov/DiversityAdmissions.

5.0 Go To Events and Visit Schools

5.1 Elementary Admissions Events

Attend an elementary admissions event this fall. At these events, you can learn about the kindergarten and Gifted & Talented admissions processes, ask questions about the kindergarten application, and find out about schools and programs. Find date, time, and location information for events near you at schools.nyc.gov/Kindergarten.

5.2 School Visits

Visiting a school is the best way to explore if it's a good place for your child. It's also a great way to see how long the trip is from home. Contact schools directly to find out if they have special events, open houses, or school tours, or check schools.nyc.gov/Kindergarten for open house dates.

Before you visit a school, prepare a list of questions for school staff and current students about the school's culture, courses, and activities.



Tip:

In the spring, families whose children get a score of 90 or above on the Gifted & Talented (G&T) test can attend open houses at schools with G&T programs. Learn more about G&T programs in **Section 7.0**. See a citywide map of schools with G&T programs at the end of the **School Information and Maps** section of this guide.

6.0 Get and Accept Your Kindergarten Offer

In March, you will get your child's kindergarten offer. This offer will tell you where your child will go to kindergarten in the fall, as well as where your child is waitlisted.

6.1 Pre-Registration

Accept your child's kindergarten offer by pre-registering at the school where you got an offer. Pre-registration secures your child's kindergarten seat at that school.

Contact the school to set up a time to pre-register. Then bring your child and all required documents. Use the checklist below to make sure you have everything you need:

KINDERGARTEN PRE-REGISTRATION CHECKLIST

Bring the following to accept your kindergarten offer and secure your seat by April 2019.

- The child that you are registering
- Proof of your child's age (child's birth certificate, passport, or baptism record)
- Your child's immunization records (if available)
- Your child's latest report card/transcript (if available), and
- Two documents verifying proof of address. Find examples of acceptable documents at schools.nyc.gov/Kindergarten—scroll down to view the online Pre-Registration Checklist.



Tip:

Students in temporary housing, as defined by McKinney-Vento, are not required to submit documentation (including address, proof of date of birth, and immunization) in order to enroll. Schools must provisionally pre-register the student and then work with the students in temporary housing DOE contact to obtain documentation.

6.2 Waitlist Offers

When a kindergarten program has more applicants than seats, a waitlist is created for that program. Your child will be automatically added to the waitlist for any school that you placed higher on your child's application than the school where they got an offer. For example, if your child got an offer to attend the school you listed third on their application, they will automatically be added to the waitlist for your first and second choice schools.

Schools will contact a waitlisted family directly if they are able to offer their child a seat. No additional action is required of families on a waitlist at this point in the admissions process.

6.3 Students Who Move During the Admissions Process

If you are a current NYC resident who moves to a different zone or district during the kindergarten admissions process, you can visit your child's new zoned school or a Family Welcome Center to update any information and discuss changes to your child's application or school. Your child's priority to attend certain schools may change if you move—learn more in **Section 4.0**.

If your family moves after the start of the school year, your child has the option to stay in their current school or to request a transfer to a closer school. Learn more at **schools.nyc.gov/Transfers**.

6.4 Transportation

Enrollment in a public elementary school, including for Gifted & Talented programs, does not guarantee school bus service. Students who are eligible for specialized transportation ("door-to-door" bus service based on an IEP) will receive bus service.

- For students not eligible for specialized service, school bus transportation may be available if your child's school is in the same district where you live. NYC offers transportation to students based on their age and the walking distance between their home and school—find details at **www.schools.nyc.gov/School-Life/Transportation/Bus-Eligibility**.

GIFTED & TALENTED ADMISSIONS

7.0 Schedule the G&T Test

Gifted & Talented (G&T) programs are one way that New York City serves the educational needs of exceptional students. To participate in G&T admissions, schedule your child to take the G&T test. Students who get a high enough score on this test can then apply to G&T programs.

7.1 Why Take the G&T Test?

There is no harm in having your child tested. The results of the G&T test are confidential to you and will not be shared with current or future schools—these scores are used only to determine eligibility to apply for G&T programs.

G&T programs are in very high demand. There are usually more eligible applicants than available seats in most G&T programs. Even if a child gets the highest score possible on the G&T test, placement is not guaranteed—there are more applicants with scores of 99 than there are seats in some G&T programs.

This table shows how many students took the G&T test, got eligible scores, applied to G&T programs, and got offers to them in 2018. Note that there are fewer available seats in the upper grades, as students typically enter a G&T program in kindergarten and remain in the program.

7.2 Types of G&T Programs

There are two types of Gifted & Talented programs:

- **District G&T programs** give an admissions priority to students who live in particular districts. These programs are offered within DOE public elementary schools, beginning in kindergarten and ending in fifth grade. Students in district G&T programs take G&T classes together in major subject areas but may share classes such as physical education or art with students who are not in the G&T program.
Score needed to apply: Students who get an overall score of 90 or above on the G&T test are eligible to apply to district G&T programs.
- **Citywide G&T programs** accept students from all boroughs and give no admissions priority for any district of residence. Every student in these schools is enrolled in the schoolwide G&T program.
Score needed to apply: Students who get an overall score of 97 or above on the G&T test are eligible to apply to both district and citywide G&T programs. Learn more about admissions priorities for district and citywide G&T programs in **Section 10.0**.

7.3 How to Schedule the Test

You can schedule your child's G&T test date and location one of two ways.

Recommended!

Online at MySchools.nyc

With MySchools, you can schedule the test in English, Spanish, Chinese, Bengali, Russian, Arabic, Urdu, Haitian Creole, Korean, or French.

In person

If you are unable to use MySchools, tear out and complete the form on the page after **Section 7.6**.

- If your child is currently enrolled in a DOE public school, bring the form to your child's current school.
- If your child is currently enrolled in a New York City Early Education Center (NYCEEC), pre-K center, private school, or charter school, bring the form to a Family Welcome Center.

You cannot schedule your child's test by mail or phone.

Tip:

When you schedule your child's test, check carefully that your contact information in MySchools ( MySchools.nyc) (or on the paper form) is up-to-date so you don't miss any important mail during G&T or kindergarten admissions.

You will get a confirmation for your child's test date in mid-December. It will include information about what to do and expect the day of the test. The G&T test is untimed and students work at their own pace. Students have as much time as they need in the testing room, but most families should expect to spend approximately one to two hours at the testing site.

7.4 Families with Multiple Children

If you have more than one child who will be testing for G&T, schedule each test separately. You are responsible for ensuring that appointments are at the same location and on the same date. If you are unable to find appointments at the same location and time, call us at **212-374-6646**.

7.5 Students in Temporary Housing

Some students in temporary housing may have needs that require special consideration in order to take the G&T test, such as changing a testing date. If this applies to your family, call the DOE Office of Assessment **212-374-6646**.

7.6 Students Who Need to Reschedule Due to Illness

If your child is sick on the day of the test, the testing site will work with you to reschedule for a different weekend as appointments become available. Email the testing site using the email address provided on the appointment letter to reschedule. If you do not have access to email, call us at **212-374-6646** on the Monday after the scheduled exam and provide the name of the school where your child was scheduled to take the exam. The testing site coordinator will contact you to find a new exam date as soon as possible.

8.0 Prepare for the G&T Test

The G&T test uses two assessments to determine if a child is eligible to apply for a G&T program:

- Nonverbal test items from the Naglieri Nonverbal Ability Test (NNAT)
- Verbal test items from the Otis-Lennon School Ability Test (OLSAT)

Assessing children in both nonverbal and verbal tests provides a balanced look at each child's intellectual abilities. The G&T test is administered by New York State certified New York City teachers who are trained to administer both assessments. The nonverbal assessment is administered first, followed by the verbal assessment.

Practice questions are included in this handbook. Review the practice questions with your child to learn about the question types they may see on the test and to help prepare them for the test-taking experience. All items are presented in a multiple-choice format.

Students with certain documented visual impairments may need large print materials. You can request a large print sample test by contacting the Office of Assessment at ServiceCenter@schools.nyc.gov or 212-374-6646.

8.1 The Nonverbal Assessment

The nonverbal G&T assessment (NNAT) measures reasoning skills without the use of spoken language. Children perform tasks such as completing patterns, sequencing, and connecting ideas in order to demonstrate an understanding of relationships and an ability to solve problems.

There are four types of nonverbal test questions: Pattern Completion, Reasoning by Analogy, Serial Reasoning, and Spatial Visualization.

Nonverbal Question Type	Definition
Pattern Completion	Measures the ability to visually perceive design patterns and identify the correct missing portions
Reasoning by Analogy	Measures the ability to recognize relationships among geometric shapes
Serial Reasoning	Measures the ability to recognize sequences among shapes
Spatial Visualization	Measures the ability to recognize how two or more objects would look if combined

8.2 The Verbal Assessment

The verbal G&T assessment (OLSAT) measures reasoning and comprehension skills that require children to pay close attention and listen carefully to oral instructions. The assessment includes tasks such as detecting likenesses and differences, recalling words and numbers, defining words, following directions, establishing sequence, and solving arithmetic problems.

There are two types of verbal test questions: Verbal Comprehension and Verbal Reasoning.

Verbal Content Cluster	Definition
Verbal Comprehension	Measures the ability to manipulate or respond to information through listening to language; e.g., following directions
Verbal Reasoning	Measures the ability to discover patterns or relationships and solve problems through the use of language such as aural reasoning and arithmetic reasoning

8.3 Testing Accommodations

Students who have Individualized Education Programs (IEPs), Individualized Education Services Programs (IESPs), or 504 Accommodation Plans may be eligible to get certain accommodations for the G&T test. Families must indicate the need for accommodations when they schedule their child's test. If a student with an IEP, IESP, or 504 Plan requires other accommodations not listed on the IEP, IESP, or 504 Plan, families must contact us at **212-374-6646** or **ServiceCenter@schools.nyc.gov**.

Families should contact students' IEP or 504 teams if they have questions or concerns about the testing accommodations listed on the IEP, IESP, or 504 Plan.

The most commonly requested testing accommodations are:

- Large print test materials for students with visual impairments;
- Frequency Modulation (FM) units for students with hearing impairments;
- Scribes for students with fine or gross motor impairments (note that responses are recorded by the test administrator for all pre-K students unless families request otherwise);
- Separate location and/or 1:1 test administration (note that all pre-K students are tested 1:1); and
- Alternate language test forms for eligible students.

Testing accommodation policies for the G&T test were created in alignment with New York State regulations and guidance. Certain testing accommodations are not provided on the G&T test either because they are unnecessary or because they change what the tests measure. Testing accommodations that are not provided include:

- **Extended time.** Both assessments are untimed, which makes requests for extended time unnecessary. All children work at their own pace, provided they actively work on completing the test.
- **Test questions or directions read more than the standard number of times.** This accommodation interferes with the assessment of receptive language skills, which the verbal assessment (OLSAT) measures. Every child who takes the OLSAT hears each question one time only. This accommodation is not necessary for the NNAT because the test is nonverbal in nature.
- **Test questions or directions explained.** This accommodation is not provided because test administrators are not permitted to change any part of the scripted test questions or directions, as they are specifically designed to assess children's reasoning and thinking abilities. This ensures test administration procedures remain consistent for all students.

If you indicate the need for testing accommodations but your child born in 2014 does not have an IEP or 504 Plan, we will contact you and ask you to submit a description of the needed accommodation along with documentation supporting this need. Documentation may include a note from the child's health-care provider.

8.4 Testing in Languages Other Than English

All students born in 2014 are eligible to take the tests in other languages. The G&T test is available in English, Spanish, Chinese (Cantonese and Mandarin), Bengali, Russian, Arabic, Urdu, Haitian Creole, Korean, and French.

If you are thinking about requesting alternate language testing for your child, you should carefully consider which language your child is most comfortable with, in order to demonstrate their abilities in a school setting. Once test administration with an alternate language has begun, the test administrator will use only that language to administer the test, and your child will not be able to retest in English. To request alternate language testing, you must indicate the requested language when you schedule your child's G&T test. To request a change of language once your G&T test has been scheduled, families of current pre-K students or other children born in 2014 should contact us at **212-374-6646**.

8.5 Test Readiness

You can help your child prepare for the G&T test by doing the following:

- Make sure your child gets a good night of sleep and eats a nutritious meal before taking the test. You can also lessen anxiety by helping to ease your child's mind about the test. Encourage them to do their best and remind them that they are not expected to know the answer to every question.
- Review the practice materials in the back of this handbook. Also read and review the information you get regarding the test and how it is given. The practice test included in this handbook can help you familiarize your child with the testing experience, sample test questions, and the test structure. Please note that we do not recommend formal test prep for the G&T test.
- Prepare your child for the test during everyday interactions. Using a variety of everyday vocabulary to describe the position of items, looking for patterns, discussing quantitative concepts like more and less, and imagining what an object would look like if it were turned upsidedown or sideways are some activities that may help children to prepare for the kind of thinking they will need to do on test day.

Also note:

- During the test, children will hear each question on the verbal test only one time.
- Children born in 2014 are not expected to bubble in their responses; instead they will point to their answers and test administrators will record their responses in the test booklet. However, if children insist on using the pencil themselves during testing, they will be allowed to do so.
- Children are allowed to write in their test booklets.
- All testing materials are provided—families are not required to bring pencils or anything else needed for testing to the testing site.

If in the judgment of the test administrator, principal, testing site supervisor, or the Office of Assessment a student has had prior exposure to the test or has gotten aid from another person during the test, the principal or site supervisor must follow our disciplinary procedure for cheating and invalidate the student's test. Invalidated tests are not submitted for scoring. In these instances, families will get communication from the us with further information.

8.6 Appeals Process for the Test Administration

We work hard to ensure that the G&T test is administered in a fair, consistent manner to all students. If, however, you feel that there was a problem with your child's test administration, you must raise that concern as an appeal to us. You may submit your appeal in one of the following ways:

This email or letter must be sent to us no later than five school days following your child's test date, and should include the following:

- Your child's name and date of birth
- The date and location of the G&T test administration
- A description of the circumstance that interfered with the G&T test administration
- Your preferred method for return communication (such as your phone number and/or email address)

If after receiving your child's score report, it comes to your attention that there was a problem with your child's test administration, you may submit an appeal to us. This appeal must be submitted following the process described above no later than five school days after receiving the score report. The appeals process applies to concerns regarding test administration; however, families needing to correct the birthdate or test date used to calculate the score must also do so within five school days of receiving the score report.

After we get your appeal:

1. We will review the test documentation and investigate the concerns raised in the appeal.
2. We will contact you if further information is needed.
3. We will make our best attempts to notify you of the result of the appeal within three weeks. You will get notification of the result via the email or phone number you provide in your initial appeal.

If we determine that the circumstances of the test administration interfered with your child's ability to perform on the G&T test, you will be offered the opportunity for your child to take the test again, using different test forms of the NNAT and OLSAT. If your child retests, the scores of the first test will be canceled and will not be used for placement.

Additional Remedy: If you are unsatisfied with our response to your appeal, you may appeal the NYCDOE's decision to the Commissioner of the New York State Education Department as stated in New York Education Law 310. 8.7 Assessment Reliability and Validity

Reliability refers to the accuracy and precision of test scores, and validity refers to the extent to which the test actually measures the skills and abilities it is intended to measure.

Each test item on the verbal and nonverbal tests was statistically analyzed and evaluated for difficulty, reliability, validity, fit, and effectiveness across each age group. All of the items were rigorously reviewed by educators, measurement specialists, and psychologists to ensure that the test is of high quality and free of bias toward any subgroup, including gender and ethnic/racial subgroups. The items were also reviewed for clarity, appropriateness of content, accuracy of correct answers, plausibility of answer options, and appropriateness of vocabulary.


8.8 Assessment Scoring

The G&T test administered in 2019 is scored with the same process used for scoring in 2018. Students' eligibility is based on their scores on both sections of the G&T test (verbal and nonverbal). Each student will get an overall G&T score that combines the scores from the two tests using a multi-step process:

- Calculate raw scores for each test
- Determine percentile ranks for each test, based on age and national norms
- Convert percentile ranks for each assessment to normal curve equivalents (NCEs)
- Calculate the average of the NCEs and convert the combination into the overall G&T score

A raw score is the total number of questions answered correctly on each test. The highest possible raw score for the verbal test is 30 (out of 30 items). The highest possible raw score for the nonverbal test is 48 (out of 48 items).

Percentile ranks are numbers between 1 and 99 that represent how a student performed on each test, compared to their similarly-aged peers. Percentile ranks for each test are determined based on students' raw scores and their age at the time of testing. Score reports show a percentile rank for each test.



The overall G&T score is a combination of the scores on the two tests arrived at through the conversion process reflected in graphic below. The overall G&T score is between 1 and 99 and is used to determine eligibility.

9.0 Get Your G&T Score Report

After your child takes the G&T test, you will get their score report by mail, as well as by email if you scheduled the test through MySchools ([MySchools.nyc](https://www.myschools.nyc.gov)). Be sure to provide your current email address and complete contact information in MySchools or on your paper form to avoid delays in receiving your child's score report. You may update your information online until **March 1, 2019**; after then, call **718-935-2009** to update your information.

9.1 Results

All students who take the G&T test will get a score report.

- If your child gets an overall G&T score of 90 or above, they will also get a G&T application—this means they are eligible to apply for placement at G&T programs.
- If your child gets an overall G&T score of 89 or below, they are not eligible to apply for placement at G&T programs. However, they will still be guaranteed a kindergarten seat in a DOE public elementary school. Learn more in **Sections 2.0-6.0** of this guide.

9.2 Eligibility

If your child has an eligible G&T score, they can apply to G&T programs. However, the two types of G&T programs have different eligible G&T scores.

- **Eligibility for district G&T programs:** Your child must get an overall G&T score of 90 or above.
- **Eligibility for citywide G&T programs:** Your child must get an overall G&T score of 97 or above. Students with a G&T score between 90 and 96 can apply to district but not citywide G&T programs.

To be eligible for placement in any G&T programs, your child must be living in New York City throughout the G&T admissions process, from the time you schedule their test to the time they get a G&T offer.



Tip:

If an eligible student does not get or accept a G&T offer for the 2019-2020 school year and wishes to apply in a future year, they must retest for eligibility.

10.0 Apply to G&T Programs

10.1 G&T Application

If your child is eligible to apply for G&T placement, you will get a G&T application and a list of G&T program options along with your score report in April.

See the **G&T Program Map** in this guide to see which schools offered G&T programs during the 2018-2019 school year. Programs may open or change from year to year. The final list of program options for the 2019-2020 school year will be provided to eligible students with their G&T application.

On your G&T application, add the G&T programs that interest you, and place them in your true order of preference. Submit your G&T application in April. The order you place programs on the application is used if your child would be eligible for offers from more than one program. In such cases, your child would only get an offer to the program you placed higher on the application.

10.2 Admissions Priorities for G&T Programs

Admissions priorities determine the order in which applicants are considered for G&T offers. Learn about your child's admissions priorities to attend particular G&T programs in **Sections 10.3-10.5**. If anything happens that might affect your child's priority to a program, email **ESEnrollment@schools.nyc.gov** right away. Your child's priority to the programs listed on your application might change if:

- Their sibling is accepted to a G&T program, or
- Your family moves to a different district.

10.3 Sibling Priority for G&T Programs


If your child applies to a G&T program at a school where their sibling is currently enrolled, they have an admissions priority to attend that program, too. In order for your child to get sibling priority, their sibling must be pre-registered or enrolled at the school or a District 75 program in the same building and be entering a grade between kindergarten and grade 12 in September 2019. Get sibling priority by providing the sibling's information in the "Siblings" section of the G&T application. If your first choice is for your child to attend the G&T program at their sibling's school, add the sibling's school as your first choice on the G&T application.

Families with siblings applying at the same time must submit a separate application for each child. Each sibling is treated as an individual applicant. However, twins and other multiples have a unique priority— they will be placed together in the same G&T program if each child is eligible for it.

- The twin who scores higher on the G&T test is considered for placement through the process described in **Sections 10.4** and **10.5**.
- If the twin who scores lower on the assessment is eligible for placement at the same program, the twins are offered placement together whenever possible.

10.4 Admissions Priorities for District G&T Programs

District G&T programs give first priority to sibling applicants who get an overall G&T score of 90 or above. After all eligible siblings are placed, non-sibling applicants are placed by overall G&T score. Eligible students may apply to any program in any district across the city, but applicants with district priority to a given program will get priority. The following figure shows the order in which applicants are considered for district G&T programs. When there are multiple students with the same priority and score, offers are randomly assigned:




Each eligible applicant has priority for one or more district programs based on the district where they are zoned for elementary school. In general, families have priority for district programs in their zoned district. However, in some cases, such as when a district does not offer a G&T program, applicants may have a priority for one or more program options in neighboring districts. Children who are zoned to or currently attend a school with a G&T program do not have any additional priority to that school over other students in the district.

10.5 Admissions Priorities for Citywide Programs

Citywide G&T programs accept students from all boroughs without preference for their district of residence. The following figure shows the order in which applicants are placed in citywide G&T programs.

When there are multiple students with the same priority and score, offers are randomly assigned.



10.6 Diversity in Admissions

Elementary schools across the city are participating in an effort to increase diversity in G&T programs by giving admissions priorities to students who qualify for free and reduced lunch (FRL), students in temporary housing, English Language Learners, and other groups. The current list of G&T programs participating in diversity pilots is available on our website—learn more at schools.nyc.gov/DiversityAdmissions.

11.0 Get Your G&T Results

If you submitted a G&T application, you will get your G&T results in **June 2019**. These results may or may not include an offer for your child to attend a G&T program.

11.1 G&T Offers

Students will only get offers to kindergarten G&T programs with available seats. There is no guarantee that a student will get an offer to a G&T program, regardless of their G&T test score. The number of eligible students typically exceeds the number of seats available.

Accept or decline your G&T offer if your child gets one. Pre-register at the school and bring your child. Your results letter will tell you what to bring when you pre-register. The deadline to accept offers will be in **June 2019**.

11.2 Grade-Level Placement

A child's date of birth determines grade placement for students born in 2014—they are eligible for kindergarten placement only.

11.3 Waitlist G&T Offers

In some cases, G&T programs may have seats that become available after offers are sent to families in June. Applicants who do not get an offer from their first-choice program will be added to the waitlists of all the programs they listed higher on their application than the program where they got an offer (or of all the programs they applied to if they got no offers). Offers from the waitlist are made based on the same admissions priorities as the initial offers—learn more in **Section 10.0**. Schools will contact waitlisted families directly if they are able to offer them a seat; no additional action is required of families at this point in the placement process.

11.4 If You Don't Get a G&T Offer

If your child does not get an offer to a kindergarten G&T program, they can take the G&T test again next year. Learn about applying to first, second, and third grade G&T programs in the NYC Gifted & Talented Admissions Guide. If your child got an eligible G&T score this year but declined or did not get an offer, they must take the G&T test again and get an eligible score any year they wish to apply to G&T programs.

District 1 Elementary Schools

This district has no zoned schools, and children living in District 1 have priority to attend all schools in the district. All District 1 schools have the same admissions priorities and make offers to students in the following order:

1. Students with a sibling at the school who live in District 1
2. Students with a sibling at the school who live outside District 1
3. Students who live in District 1 and are currently enrolled at the school for pre-K
4. Students who live outside District 1 and are currently enrolled at the school for pre-K
5. Other students who live in District 1
6. Other students who live outside District 1

Diversity in Admissions

As part of a Diversity in Admissions pilot, students in temporary housing, English Language Learners (ELL), and students who qualify for the Federal free or reduced lunch (FRL) program have an admissions priority for 67% of kindergarten offers at every District 1 elementary school. Students who do not fall into any of these three groups will get a priority for the other 33% of offers. Within each group, offers are made according to the same admissions priorities listed above. District 1 families are welcome to call or visit District 1's new Family Resource Center (FRC) to learn about your kindergarten options and get personalized help with any aspect of Elementary Admissions before, during, and after the admissions process.

Say **Now we are going to do some interesting activities that are like puzzles. Leave your booklet closed until I tell you what to do.**

Say **Open your booklet to the first page of the next part of the test. Now look at the first row, where you see a little chair at the beginning of the row. Put your finger on the chair.**

Make sure that your child has opened the booklet correctly and has the first page of the verbal practice test showing.

Say

1 When pictures go across the page like this, we say they are in a row.

Demonstrate by moving your finger across the page from left to right.

Say **Be sure you can see the answer spaces. Look at the building blocks next to the little chair. Find the number that is right below a heart. In the next part of the row, mark under that number.**

Pause while your child marks the answer.

Say **What number is right below a heart?**

Pause for reply.

Say **Yes, the number 2 is the only number that is right below a heart. The number 3 is next to a heart but it is not under one. The number 5 is above a heart, and the number 6 is next to a heart. Do you understand why the number 2 is the correct answer? Tell me if you do not understand what we just did.**

Answer any questions. Then go on to question 2.

Say

2 Put your finger under the next row, where you see the scissors. Mark the space under the picture that shows this: A girl is sitting between a dog and a cat and watching a TV show. A lamp is in back of the TV.

Pause while your child marks the answer.

Say **Did you mark under the first picture? The first picture is the only one that shows a girl between a cat and a dog, with a lamp behind the TV.**

Answer any questions. Explain further, if necessary.

Say

3 Now put your finger on the next row, the one with the rainbow. Look at the box next to the rainbow. The box has circles and letters in it. In the next part of the row, mark under the letter that is inside both circles.

Pause.

Say **Which space did you mark?**

Pause for reply.

Say **Yes, the third answer is the correct one, isn't it? Only the letter C is inside both circles. The letters B and D are each inside only one circle, and the letter A is outside both circles. If you marked the space under a different letter, erase your mark and mark the space under the letter C. Are there any questions?**

Answer any questions your child may have.

Say

4 Now move your finger to the last row, the one with the kite. Mark under the box where there is a triangle next to a square that has a circle inside it.

Pause while your child marks the answers.

Say **Did you mark the first answer? It is the only one that has a triangle next to a square that has a circle inside it. Do you understand why the other answers are wrong?**

Say **Which picture did you mark?**

Pause for reply.

Say **Yes, the fourth picture is the only one that shows two things to wear and one thing to play with. Do you understand why the fourth picture is the correct answer?**

Make sure that your child understands question 6.

Say **That is all we will do now. Put your pencil down. In a few days, you will be doing some more problems like these. They will seem familiar to you, because you will remember how they work. Close your booklet so that the front cover is on top.**

Demonstrate. Then collect the test booklet. This concludes the Practice Test.
