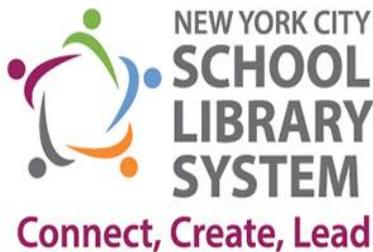




Keep the learning going this summer with free e-books and learning resources for all NYC students!
